As mentioned in a previous issue of Acta, such collaborative activities will allow, by means of recognized indices and relevant databases, to carry out bibliometric analysis based on indicators such as percentage of scientific papers, total number of documents per year, evolution of production by institution and author, number of references, percentage of national and international references, number of documentation citations, total number of authors per year, number of articles per country and average of papers per year, among others.

We take this opportunity to thank all the authors of the articles, the research groups and networks, our referees, the members of the Editorial and Scientific Committees, and the methodological, statistical, technical and style reviewers.
