The Editorial Direction, in line with its policy of excellence, is constantly working in order to make the access to the contents of the journal increasingly open, in accordance with the policy of social projection of Sergio Arboleda University; because this way a tool is transferred, and provided for the appropriation of knowledge generated by academic and scientific community.
